

PCNAK 2024 Sports Tournament General Guidelines:
MI3 Center: 1135 Ella Crossing Dr. Houston, Tx 77090

- All players must be registered attendees of PCNAK 2024. All players will be required to check in with their conference registration badges prior to playing. Any player that does not have a conference registration badge will not be eligible to play in this year's tournament.
- There is a limit of 14 players per team for basketball and volleyball.
- All players on the women's teams must be females. All players on the men's teams must be males.
- Players may play in two sports, but the schedule will **NOT** be changed to accommodate any overlapping games.
- Players may not play in wheelchairs or use any type of brace or support made of anything besides plastic or fabric to prevent causing harm to other players. Players may not wear jewelry on court to prevent causing harm to other players. Hats, hair ties or any type of head gear that includes a bill or metal is not allowed to be worn by players during games to prevent causing harm to other players. Please use rubber bands or fabric hair ties. Bandanas are allowed.
- Teams will be notified about when and where each game will take place via a projector and screen. Please refrain from approaching any "STAFF" members or volunteers to ask for this information. Nobody will be speaking directly to teams or captains about their games. It is the team's responsibility to check their status consistently.
- Each game will start at the scheduled time. Teams must be present at that time and failure to be present may result in forfeiture of that game.
- Certified professional referees will officiate all games.
- Food purchased outside of the facility **may not** be brought into the facility and must be consumed elsewhere. There will be a café inside the facility where food and drinks may be purchased at each individual's own expense, if desired.
- Game balls will be provided during the tournament. Teams will be required to bring their own equipment for practice and warm ups.
- No foul language or physical altercations will be tolerated. Security will be on site and has the authority to remove an individual from the facility at any time
- Each team must have both a light-colored uniform and a dark-colored uniform that can be used for gameplay. All uniforms must have legible numbers on the back.
